2.LINGUISTIC REQUIREMENTS

Erasmus students should have **sufficient knowledge of the Greek language** since most of the courses are taught in Greek. However, for Erasmus students, courses can also be offered on a tutorial basis in one of the main European languages and the examinations have the form of essay writing or written exams. There are also practical courses found in Departments such as the Music Dept, Audiovisual Dept. etc.

Extra courses (accredited with ECTS) are offered especially for Incoming Erasmus students in an interdepartmental level.

First Language of instruction and examination: Greek

Recommended level: B1

Certification is not required but sufficient knowledge would be considered an important element for the smooth integration to life in Corfu and to the University lectures' participation.

The Ionian University offers **Greek Language Course for Erasmus students** during the academic year (October- June), free of charge, accredited with six (6) ECTS per semester.

Second Language: English

Required level: B1

Regarding the B1 English level, students can be admitted after having proved the knowledge with a language certificate, a support letter proving the required language level or a certificate issued by the home University or language centers.

Also Available: French, German, Italian according to the tutor.

It is necessary to consult all information early enough, so as to fulfill all obligations required in time.

Non EU citizens must obtain their study visa and residence permit from their country's embassy or consulate.

All citizens must be addressed to the Greek Consulate of their country.

It is the consul's duty to validate or not the visa.

If you are EU citizen you need only a valid identity document.

If you are from another country and expect to stay longer than three months, you need to address yourself to the *Ministry of Interior*- Aliens and Immigration Department, Corfu (+30)

Health insurance is compulsory.

EU Citizens

EU citizens should have with them the **E.H.I.C.** card valid for the previewed study period issued by the relevant Heath Institution in the student's Home Country.

In case of a special health problem or if you don't have the EHIC card with you during your trip, it is strongly recommended to have a private insurance for the Erasmus period (both for health insurance and civil responsibility).

Non EU Citizens

Non EU Citizens are strongly recommended to have health insurance coverage for the previewed Erasmus+ study period before leaving their home country. Upon arrival they must show at the Host Institution's Secretariat a copy of the relevant document available in English.

The Ionian University doesn't provide any housing.

Renting in Corfu is not too expensive. One should estimate approximately 250€-400€ / per month (it depends on the type: flat-sharing small apartment etc.). Rooms can be found through the following http://sites.ionio.gr/erent

or other sites in internet or by consulting the relevant notice boards located at the entrances of the University's building facilities.

It is the student's responsibility to find accommodation.

26613 61553) in order to obtain a **Residence Permit**.

For the issuing of the Residence Permit you need:

- Application form in two copies
- Valid passport
- Entry Visa Type D issued for the particular study period
- 3 recent colored photos Passport type (They must be available in CD/JEPG2000 form as well)
- Certification of the Host Institution (Ionian University), testifying that you are Erasmus student and specifying the exact Erasmus+ period studies
- Certificate of scholarship testifying that the student can cover all his expenses during his/her stay in Greece
- Type B Fee
- Health certificate from a State Hospital(*), that will testify that the Erasmus+ student does not suffer from a disease, that according to the WHO can be considered as a threat to public health
- Health insurance
- A solemn statement for permanent residence

NB. All the above documents must be original, in duplicate and translated in Greek or English.

- (*) At the Hospital (26613 60400) normally you pay a **fee of 10€** and then you are asked to undertake the following examinations:
- -Mantoux test(Anti-Tuberculosis Unit)
- X-ray (lungs)
- Lung examination
- -General practitioner examination

Then the Hospital will issue the Health Certificate the same day.

COST OF LIVING

The average cost for living (except accommodation) in Corfu amounts to 400€ approx. per month.

As an ERASMUS student you have the possibility to get two full meals per day in the restaurant contracted with the Ionian University by paying the reduced price of 2 € approximately per meal directly to the Restaurant.

ERASMUS students can get further information on the contracted restaurant from the Accommodation Office.
